Sign the Camper *B'rit* (Behavior Contract)

The Ramah Day Camp Summer 2026 *B'rit* (Covenant) lays out basic behavioral expectations for the summer which are tied to camp's rich Jewish environment and educational vision. These expectations are based on our four core values, which are deeply grounded in Jewish tradition:

- **Connection** - *Kehillah k'doshah*: Camp is a holy community.
- **Inclusion** - *B'tzelem Elohim*: We are all created in the image of God.
- **Joy** - *Bishvili nivra ha'olam*: Each of us is so important that we could say that the entire universe was created for our sake.
- **Growth** - *Talmud torah k'neged kulam*: Learning is of paramount importance, of equal value to following all other commandments.

We ask that you read the full *B'rit* in the Forms section of your [CampMinder account](#) or in your [Campanion app](#), have a conversation about the content of the *B'rit* with your camper, and then sign the *B'rit*, so we may partner together to build our holy Ramah community this summer. **Please sign the *B'rit* by May 10.**
